COURSE DESCRIPTION

This qualification provides a general vocational outcome in agriculture. The qualification enables individuals to select a livestock production or cropping context as a job focus or, in the case of mixed farming enterprises, both.

Participants will get experience in preparing and applying chemicals; undertaking basic soil/media analysis tests; machinery operation and maintenance; identifying pests and diseases; monitoring the health and maturity of crops; moving, drafting and controlling livestock; and assessing herd/flock health and conditions.

Job roles and titles vary across different industry sectors. Possible job titles relevant to this qualification include farm or station hand; farm or station worker; and livestock transport driver.
