QUALIFICATION

Upon successful completion of the course you will receive a nationally recognised qualification.

SKILLS AND ATTRIBUTES

- Show a demonstrated commitment to Workplace Health and Safety.
- Have an interest in the care, nurturing and development of young children.
- Be able to follow basic food safety practices.
- Ability to work independently.
- May be required to complete a NSW Working with Children Check.
- Provide NSW Health with your Health Care Workers/ Student Vaccination Record Card following the appropriate screening and vaccinations.
- Must be 18 years of age.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Employees will learn how to use organisation policies, procedures and individual children's profiles to plan activities and provide care to children, facilitating their leisure and play and enabling them to achieve their developmental outcomes. Contribute to provision of nutritionally balanced food in a safe and hygienic manner. Apply basic first aid. Depending on the setting, employees may work under direct supervision or autonomously.

CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

Child care assistant, playground supervisor, family day care worker, child care worker, outside school hours care assistant, recreation assistant or nanny.

TERM OF TRAINING

12 months nominal term (1 year).

WAGES

Pay rates are as per the relevant Modern Award.
