

Frequently asked questions

What is a traineeship?

A traineeship is supervised vocational training where you earn a wage and complete your qualification at the same time. A traineeship is just like an apprenticeship, but often takes place in an office environment. These traineeships can take up to 24 months to complete and upon completion you will receive a Cert III or IV in Information Technology or a Cert IV in Cyber Security*.

How do the IT Traineeships work?

The NSW Government Information Technology Traineeships are office-based.

Successful candidates will:

- Spend four (4) days per week working at a NSW Government agency
- Spend one (1) day per week in formal training
- Gain industry relevant vendor specific training
- Have support and mentoring services.

Do I attend classes to study?

You will be provided 1 day during the week to study and complete your Cert III or IV qualification, within work hours.

Classes can take the form of in-person instruction/ assessments, virtual classrooms (i.e. connecting learning and/or online learning (i.e. online reading materials/ assessments)).

What is industry relevant vendor specific training?

In addition to a Cert III or IV qualification, this traineeship will provide you an opportunity to undertake training and gain accreditation across a range of vendor-specific products (e.g. Microsoft Azure).

What experience do I need?

No prior experience is required. We are seeking candidates who have finished school and are keen to start a career in Information Technology.

Where are these Traineeships located in NSW?

There are approximately 70 Traineeships available in 2022 across NSW, mostly in Sydney metro with the remainder in regional NSW.

How much will I get paid?

If you're successful, you will earn a minimum annual salary of at least \$32,000**.

When would I start?

If you're successful, you will commence the traineeship from April 2022.

What happens after I complete my traineeship?

At the end of your two-year IT traineeship, you will be a qualified and knowledgeable employee, valued by private and public sector organisations.

You could continue pursuing further study in IT or apply for IT roles with private and public sector organisations which are in high demand.
